February 21, 2012

Treasurer's report – The club balance is \$1,527.

Safety report – No report.

Field report – A vote was taken to authorize the purchase of two metal garbage cans and one lid. A work day is scheduled for Saturday 2/25 at 10 AM. A pilot station needs to be repaired. The gate needs to be raised and the lock cleaned and oiled. The shed needs to be cleaned and organized.

Intro pilot report – Several new pilots need training.
