CAM Meeting Minutes  
February 18, 2014

**Old business** – Seth reported the cost to prepare, seed and fertilize the ¼ acre of old runway would be approximately \$310. Options of using fertilizer or chicken manure were discussed; the manure seemed to be favored. A vote approved the expenditure of up to \$350 for this project. April 26 was designated the date for the seeding project. The old tarp and staples will be removed from the old runway on April 19.

It was decided on a combat build versus abstract. All will use the same frame found at [www.warwingdelta.com](http://www.warwingdelta.com). The meet will be held on April 19, the same day as the removal of the old runway.
